The above is a breakdown of the daily consumable costs for a child based on a full day.

Consumable fees are only applied to funded hours. To calculate the hourly consumable figure, the daily amount is divided into hours per day: **£15 divided by 10 hours**, give us an hourly consumable fee of **£1.50**.

If your child attends half day they will not consume all meals, however this is why calculate it based on the hours and not a full day. This is added to your weekly funded hours claimed.

Extra-Curricular: Can participate in all extra-curricular activities such as; yoga, cooking, PE, Dance, music and languages Can attend all trips: with the support of a nursery practitioner and no additional fees (If it falls on child's day). Additional costs will apply for admission or travel, depending on nature of the trip e.g. annual trip or ticket cost - Sun cream, toothpaste etc will be offered.
